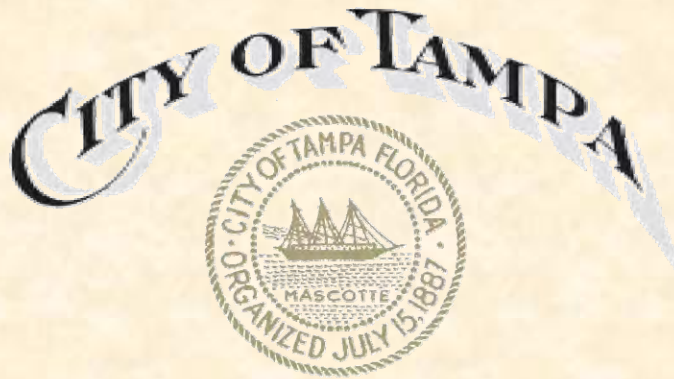


# Proclamation
