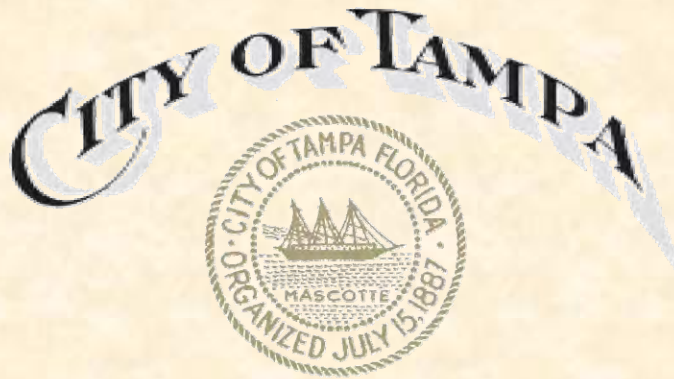


# Proclamation
