

**A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE PROPOSAL OF KIMMINS CONTRACTING CORP. PERTAINING TO CONTRACT 11-C-00003; HOWARD F. CURREN AWTP PIPING AND CONDUIT REHABILITATION, BID IN THE AMOUNT OF \$1,294,036.66; AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF THE CONTRACT BY THE MAYOR OF THE CITY OF TAMPA; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

WHEREAS, on January 18, 2011, the Mayor received bids, tabulation of such bids being hereto attached for informational purposes for the construction of Howard F. Curren AWTP Piping and Conduit Rehabilitation, and recommends to this Council that the proposal of Kimmins Contracting Corp. be accepted, funds therefore being available in the appropriate account;

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TAMPA, FLORIDA, THAT:

Section 1. The proposal of Kimmins Contracting Corp. in the total amount of \$1,294,036.66 for construction of the Howard F. Curren AWTP Piping and Conduit Rehabilitation, in accordance with plans, specifications and other related contract documents prepared by the Contract Administration Department, is hereby approved and accepted; and the Contract is hereby awarded to the said Contractor.

Section 2. This Resolution, which is not part of the contract documents, authorizes the Mayor to execute and the City Clerk to attest and affix the official seal of the City of Tampa to the Contract for and on behalf of the City of Tampa.

Section 3. Plans, specifications and contract documents for the construction of said Project, which documents are now on file in the office of the City Clerk of the City of Tampa, are hereby approved in their entirety or in substantially similar form.

Section 4. The Director of the Contract Administration Department is hereby authorized to issue, in written form only, work directive changes authorizing additions, deletions or revisions resulting from unforeseen conditions or emergencies, said directives to be incorporated in subsequently issued change orders approved by the City Council.

Section 5. Any and all technical errors, informalities and irregularities in the proposal of the Contractor are hereby waived.

Section 6. The bid security of the bidders shall be returned in accordance with the provisions of the contract documents for this project.


Section 7. The project construction costs in the amount of \$1,294,036.66 are provided in the City Budget for the Fiscal Year ending September 30, 2011, in Account No(s). SS0442BDR-06300.

Section 8. Other proper officers of the City of Tampa are authorized to do all things necessary and proper in order to carry out and make effective the provisions of this Resolution, which shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.



	This includes the furnishing of all labor, equipment and material for rehabilitation of the Primary Sedimentation Tanks (1-4 and 5-8) 66" effluent pipes by slip lining 950 LF of 63" (IPS-OD) DR-26 HDPE liner pipe, installation of (1) 63" (IPS-OD) DR-26 fabricated HDPE 900 band, cement grout to fill annular space around liner pipe, insertion pits and access openings required to install HDPE pipe, including sheeting and shoring, backfilling, and restoration of disturbed areas, as specified. Work also includes the rehabilitation of the Screen and Grit Buildings 1 and 2 effluent conduits by shotcrete of a calcium aluminate system followed by a structural coating system including installation of steel wire mesh and dowels, expansion joint repair and surface preparation. Work also includes the temporary relocation of the 8" air cooling discharge pipe within Screen and Grit Building #1 and relocation of the 14" DIP thickening tanks overflow pipe. The project will include the fabrication of 5 stainless steel stop logs, installation and removal of the stop logs, cleaning of all pipes and conduits to be rehabilitated, removal and proper disposal of debris with all associated
