RFQ 11-D-00012; Ybor Pumping Station Rehabilitation Design

PUBLIC ANNOUNCEMENT IN COMPLIANCE WITH REQUIREMENTS OF CHAPTER 287.055, LAWS OF FLORIDA, CONSULTANTS COMPETITIVE NEGOTIATION ACT, AS AMENDED AND THE CITY OF TAMPA'S EQUAL BUSINESS OPPORTUNITY PROGRAM

RFQ- 11-D-00012 - The City of Tampa desires to obtain professional **Engineering Services for the design of Ybor City Pumping Station Rehabilitation.** The pumping station is located at 1302 North 25th Street. This project provides for the design of: rehabilitation of pump motor No. 1 (800 HP); the replacement of pumping system No.2, which includes installation of a new pump, motor and variable frequency drive for pump No.2 (Ex. 800 HP and new 300 HP); replacement of pump No. 3 with the existing 800 HP motor to remain; and the replacement of the variable frequency drive for pump No.4 (300 HP). All 4 pneumatically actuated discharge valves will need to be replaced. The project will also include replacement and testing of the electric feeder cables; rehabilitation and testing of the 4160 volt switchgear, 4160 volt motor control center, and 480 volt motor control center; replacement of protective relays for the 4160 volt TECO feeders and pumps/motors No.1 & No.3; and other electric improvements needed to ensure station reliability. The new variable frequency drives must be housed in a climate controlled enclosure with a new HVAC system which may require modifications to the existing enclosure or construction of a new enclosure. The scope of the design will also include developing a sequence of operation and the construction requirements so that wastewater flow is maintained throughout the construction of the rehabilitation.

Estimated Engineering Service Fees: \$100,000 - \$125,000.

Construction Estimate: \$1,900,000. Services will include but may not be limited to program refinement, construction cost estimating, schematic design, design development, preparation of construction documents for bidding, submittal and tracking of all regulatory permit applications, shop drawing review, and associated activities required during construction.

A pre-submittal conference will be held at 3 P.M. Tuesday October 12th, 2010 in the 3rd Floor City Council Chambers, Old City Hall 315 E. Kennedy Blvd., Tampa, Florida 33602. Attendance is not mandatory.
