RFQ- 09-D-00028 - The City of Tampa desires to obtain Professional Engineering and Landscape Architectural services associated with the development of the **Zack Street Avenue of the Arts - Design.**

Services may include but not be limited to engineering and design development for the Avenue of the Arts improvements to Zack Street between Nebraska Avenue and Ashley Drive. Some previous conceptual design options for street reconfiguration are available for review at the link provided below. These concepts emphasize adding pedestrian character to this road segment along with the incorporation of public art, cultural amenities, and landscaping.

Project scope includes further development to create a concept design which will be refined and completed to full construction plans for the construction of the Zack Street corridor. Included will be services during construction, assistance with coordination of project art elements, and other related activities.

The design project fee is estimated at \$200,000.

A Pre-Submission Conference for this project will be conducted at 3:00PM Tuesday, July 21st, 2009, at 306 E. Jackson Street, Tampa, Florida, in the City Council Chambers 3rd - Floor Old City Hall. Attendance is not mandatory.
