City of Tampa Reclaimed Water Signage

Information required to be included on signage for using reclaimed water in fountains and other decorative water features.

Governing Statute: Chapter 62-610.468 Access Control and Advisory Signs

Location of Signs for Fountains: Signs must be posted at main entryway(s) and/or access point(s) to the fountain(s) to ensure the public is informed that reclaimed water is in use.

Style, Color, Size of Signs: Signs must include the required information listed below; must conform to Tampa's Sign Code (Chapter 20.5), and it is encouraged, but not required, that purple be used as prominent color. (In general, if the required language is included, and the sign(s) is/are properly displayed, then signage may be designed as deem appropriate by the user for the location.

Required Information to be included on signs:

- 1.) Investing in Neighborhoods logo as shown here. Electronically version is available.



- 2.) City of Tampa Reclaimed Water
- 3.) International symbols paired with English and Spanish Text as shown here.
