RESOLUTION NO. 2007- 752

A RESOLUTION SUPERSEDING AND RESCINDING THAT PARTICULAR PORTION OF SECTION 1 OF RESOLUTION 2004-602 REGARDING THE RECLAIMED WATER RATE SCHEDULE; ESTABLISHING A NEW RECLAIMED WATER RATE PURSUANT TO SECTION 26-31, CITY OF TAMPA CODE; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, it is necessary for the City of Tampa to adjust certain reclaimed water rates to accommodate the increased costs to provide services.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TAMPA, FLORIDA:

Section 1. This Resolution supersedes and rescinds only that particular portion of Section 1 of Resolution No. 2004-602 passed and approved by City Council on May 13, 2004, regarding the Reclaimed Water Rate Schedule with the remainder of Resolution No. 2004-602 remaining in full force and effect. Any other Resolution that is in conflict with this Resolution is superseded and rescinded.

Section 2. That pursuant to the authority of Section 26-31, City of Tampa Code, the following is the schedule of reclaimed water rates required under Chapter 26 relating to Water Department activities:

A. RECLAIMED WATER RATE SCHEDULE


1. Residential Reclaimed Customers: Quantity of reclaimed water used, based on reclaimed water meter readings on reclaimed water used, per hundred cubic feet (CCF): \$1.20
2. Non-Residential Reclaimed Customers: Quantity of reclaimed water used, based on reclaimed water meter readings on reclaimed water used, per hundred cubic feet (CCF): \$1.20

Section 3. That the proper officers of the City of Tampa are authorized and directed to do all things necessary and proper in order to carry out and make effective the provisions of this Resolution.

Section 4. That the rates established by this Resolution shall be utilized in calculating bills beginning on the first billing cycle in October 2007.
