

A RESOLUTION AMENDING AND SUPERSEDING THAT PARTICULAR PORTION OF SECTION 2 OF RESOLUTION NO. 2007-753 REGARDING THE WATER RATE SCHEDULE APPLICABLE TO RESIDENTIAL WATER USE ONLY; ESTABLISHING TWO ADDITIONAL TIERS FOR HIGH WATER USERS PURSUANT TO SECTION 26-31, CITY OF TAMPA CODE; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City has determined that a water conservation rate structure which provides a price signal to customers reflecting the higher cost of water for higher consumption is an effective tool to assist the City in it's demand management and water conservation efforts; and

WHEREAS, the addition of two additional tiers of higher rates for higher quantity water users will provide the City's Water Department with another tool to implement such demand management and water conservation efforts.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TAMPA, FLORIDA:

Section 1. This Resolution amends and supersedes that particular portion of Section 2 of Resolution No. 2007-753 passed and approved by City Council on August 9, 2007, regarding the Water Rate Schedule, with the remainder of Resolution No. 2005-1165 still effective. Any other Resolution that is in conflict with this Resolution is superseded and rescinded.

Section 2. That pursuant to the authority of Section 26-31, City of Tampa Code, the rates shown below establish an upper limit to the existing Tier 4 monthly usage and add two additional tiers to the residential schedule of water rates required under Chapter 26 relating to Water Department activities:

A. WATER RATE SCHEDULE

The rates for water furnished by the City to the customers shall be based upon the quantity of water, determined by metering, furnished to each premise, each billing period or upon the minimum monthly charges, whichever is greater. Different rates are to be charged to premises inside and outside the city limits pursuant to any applicable inter-local agreement and state statute.

Section 3. That the proper officers of the City of Tampa are authorized and directed to do all things necessary and proper in order to carry out and make effective the provisions of this Resolution.

Section 4. That the rates established by this Resolution shall be utilized in calculating bills beginning on the first billing cycle in May 2010 for the remainder of this fiscal year and each fiscal year as indicated herein.
