All PROPOSALS that have been timely received will be opened publicly.

PROJECT Description - The Name of the PROJECT is Carrollwood Collection Main - Contract 2, PROJECT NO.: 04901.

Location - The PROJECT is located in Hillsborough County, Florida.

General - Description of WORK - The WORK contemplated consists of: Construction of 10-inch and 12-inch diameter raw water collection mains.

PUBLIC ENTITY CRIMES STATEMENT - In accordance with the requirements of Section 287.133, Florida Statutes, the following statement is hereby made:

"A person or affiliate who has been placed on the convicted vendor list following a conviction for a public entity crime may not submit a bid on a contract to provide any goods or services to a public entity, may not submit a bid on a contract with a public entity for the construction or repair of a public building or public work, may not submit bids on leases of real property to a public entity, may not be awarded or perform work as a contractor, supplier, subcontractor, or consultant under a contract with any public entity, and may not transact business with any public entity in excess of the threshold amount provided in Section 287.017 for CATEGORY TWO for a period of 36 months from the date of being placed on the convicted vendor list."
