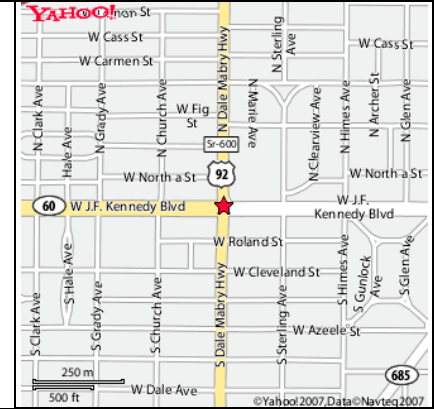

PROJECT TITLE: Kennedy Boulevard and Dale Mabry Highway Intersection Improvement
RESPONSIBLE DEPARTMENT: Public Works

PROJECT DESCRIPTION:
 This project provides for a northbound through lane on Dale Mabry Highway at the intersection of Kennedy Boulevard. This will expand the northbound, south leg of the intersection to three through lanes to align with the three lanes on the north side of the intersection. This project provides for the development, design and construction of the intersection improvements as well as the acquisition of right-of-way on the southeast corner of the intersection. The project will also provide geometric improvements and pedestrian facilities. Improvements to the intersection will increase the traffic volume capacity of the roadway and enhance vehicular and pedestrian safety. The project will be coordinated with the state since both intersecting roadways are under jurisdiction of the Florida department of transportation.

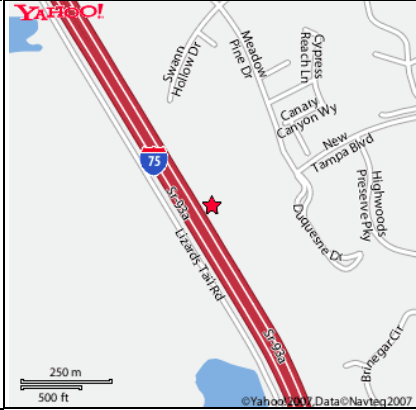

PROJECT DESCRIPTION:

This project provides for a four-lane bridge over I-75 that will extend New Tampa Boulevard through West Meadows over I-75 to Commerce Park Boulevard and the proposed East-West road. This roadway extension will provide immediate capacity relief in the New Tampa area. It also will connect the residential areas, schools, and parks that are currently separated by I-75. The roadway will initially be a two-lane extension of New Tampa Boulevard. The bridge will be built with four lanes for anticipated future demand. Additional funding sources include the community investment tax and local option gas tax bonds.

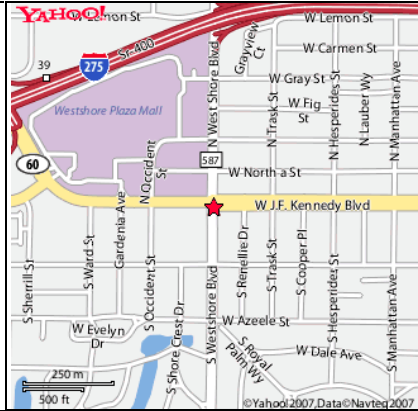

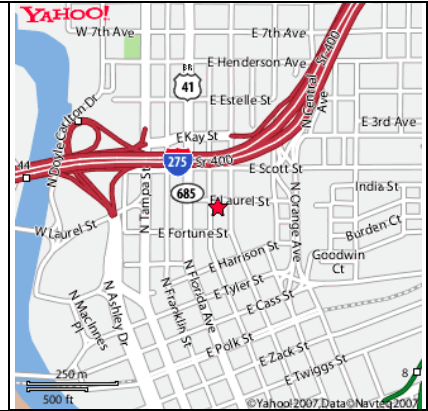

The city acquired a Florida department of transportation Local Agency Project (LAP) grant for Segment C for right-of-way and construction.

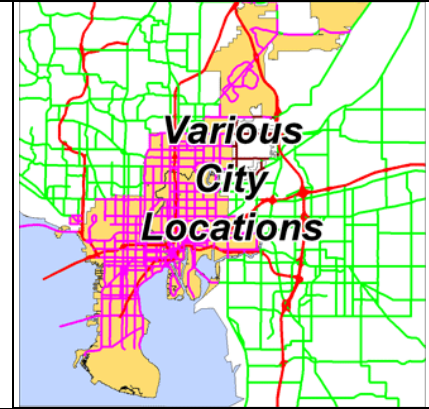

Improvements may result from private residential, or commercial development or transportation needs that aid traffic flow in the district. This funding will provide minimal design plans for future intersection and corridor improvements in the Central Business district that would improve the congestion and capacity of some downtown streets.

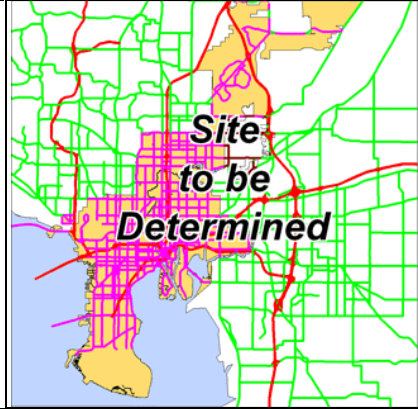
