



**2009 CLEAN CITY DAY ART CONTEST
GUIDELINES
(9th - 12th GRADE STUDENTS)**

1. Design must be on letter-sized, 8.5 X 11 paper.
2. Each design should portray a clean city idea with a pirate or treasure chest theme, including the tagline, “A Clean City is Worth Preserving”. Students may use crayons, pencils, markers, paint, or computer generated artwork.
3. Each piece of artwork should have the student’s name, grade and school written on the back. Be sure to use pencil so that the writing doesn’t show through on the design side of the paper. **All published materials and awards will display your school name, teacher name(s), principal’s name and student names exactly as they are provided on this entry form.**

Please include a completed release form from the parents of each student whose original work is being forwarded.

4. Each school may submit up to **five designs**. Selection should be based on subject matter, creativity and originality, as well as artistic ability.
5. Entries must be received by Phyllis Alexandroff, Art Supervisor, by **January 30, 2009**.
6. A celebrity panel will select a first, second, and third place winner to be recognized at the 3rd Annual Clean City Day Celebration, March 28, 2009, at Al Lopez Park. Award-winning students receive framed copies of their artwork, and prize packages. The first place winner will receive \$300.00 and will have his or her artwork made into a poster. The Art Department of the first place student will receive \$200.00.
