RFQ 6-C-76: The City of Tampa desires to obtain **Design-Build services** for enhancements at a group of **Stormwater Management Ponds**.

The projects include, but are not limited to, design and construction of aesthetic enhancements and recreational amenities for Stormwater retention ponds at various locations.

Services will be provided under a contract for a negotiated fixed fee for design, project management, overhead, profit and a guaranteed maximum price for construction with appropriate surety bonds. Services will also include coordination or scheduling during design phase, cost estimating, advertising and administering subcontracts and all related work required for a complete project at each location. Work at about three ponds is anticipated over the next few years. Currently, funding for work at one pond is planned at about \$500,000.

As the first step in the Qualifications Based Selection process, firms will be certified for further consideration (shortlisted) on the basis of comparing the submitted materials using the following general criteria: Experience with Projects of Similar Scope and Complexity, 35%; Design-Build Exper., 20%; Government Project Admin Exp, 15%; Staff Adequacy, 10%; Office Proximity/ Workload 5%; Past Performance/Low Amount of Previous City Work, 5%; W/MBE Participation, 5%; **Form A-305**(in lieu of 330/254), 5%.
