RFQ 7-C-95; High Service Pumping; Design-Build

RFQ- 7-C-95 - The City of Tampa desires to obtain Professional **Design-Build** services in connection with **High Service Pumping Improvements**. Services will include, but will not be limited to, engineering investigation, surveying, hydraulic modeling, preliminary design, final design, permitting, construction, start-up, operations & maintenance instruction and staff training. Scope of the work may include but will not be limited to Installation of five new variable speed pumps, replacement of three variable speed drives, installation of two variable speed drives, upgrade of yard piping, metering, controls and associated work at the City's two water treatment facilities as funding becomes available over the next three fiscal years.

Services will be provided under a contract with negotiated fixed fees for each phase for completion of design, permitting, project management, overhead, profit and a guaranteed maximum price for each phase of construction with appropriate surety bonds. Services will also include coordination of scheduling during design phase, cost estimating, advertising and administering subcontracts and all related work required for a complete project.

Background: The Tampa Water Department (TWD) currently owns and operates eight (8) High Service Pumps (HSPs) with a firm capacity of 156 MGD at the David L. Tippin Water Treatment Facility, (DLTWTF), and four (4) Variable Speed Drive Pumps at the Morris Bridge Water Treatment Plant. This project will proactively update pumping equipment and associated piping in an effort to 1) Increase useable finished water storage, 2) Efficiently utilize proposed transmission mains, 3) Phase out aging pumps & drives, 4) Address yard pipe sizing/configuration concerns, 5) Avoid emergency funding and 6) Address reliability concerns.

This project is anticipated to be phased. The project has been allotted \$2,500,000 for FY08. Additional funding may become available in subsequent fiscal years or through bonding.
