PUBLIC ANNOUNCEMENT IN COMPLIANCE WITH REQUIREMENTS OF CHAPTER 287.055, LAWS OF FLORIDA, CONSULTANTS COMPETITIVE NEGOTIATION ACT, AS AMENDED AND THE CITY OF TAMPA'S WOMEN / MINORITY BUSINESS ENTERPRISE PROGRAM

**RFQ- 7-D-11** - The City of Tampa desires to obtain professional engineering services associated with the design of the **Drew Park CRA Stormwater Project**. The project includes a stormwater conveyance, pumping and detention system for installation of approximately 9,000 L.F. stormwater pipe and a box culvert, and a stormwater pumping station with emergency generator and enclosure in the Drew Park Community Redevelopment Area. The project area is bounded by Tampa International Airport to the west; Tampa Bay Boulevard to the South; Dale Mabry Highway to the East; and Henry Avenue to the North.

Services may include but not limited to: survey; geotechnical investigations; stormwater modeling; stormwater system design; permitting (all applicable agencies); preparation of contract drawings and documents for construction; coordination with adjacent utilities and design of City utility relocations, coordination with FDOT and other government agencies; and any related activities. Additional services may include design of roadway improvements, landscaping and irrigation; and streetscape features.

The firm selected for this project will have demonstrated considerable specific experience with design of stormwater pumping; SWMM modeling, including "2-D" capabilities; surveying in accordance with COT standards, preparation of construction drawings and specifications; coordination with adjacent utilities and other governmental agencies; submitting and obtaining all required permits; on-schedule delivery of final plans and other contract documents for construction.

A Pre-Submission Conference for this project will be conducted at 3:00PM Tuesday October 24<sup>th</sup>, at 306 E. Jackson Street, Tampa, Florida, in the 4th Floor Conference Room. Attendance is not mandatory.
