PUBLIC ANNOUNCEMENT IN COMPLIANCE WITH REQUIREMENTS OF CHAPTER 287.055, LAWS OF FLORIDA, CONSULTANTS COMPETITIVE NEGOTIATION ACT, AS AMENDED AND THE CITY OF TAMPA'S WOMEN / MINORITY BUSINESS ENTERPRISE PROGRAM

RFQ- 7-D-36 - The City of Tampa desires to obtain professional Engineering services to perform the **Downtown Tampa Circulation Modeling Study**. The study will provide a full evaluation of existing traffic conditions, existing and projected land uses in the area located South of Interstate 275, West of the Ybor Channel, north of Garrison Channel, and east of the Hillsborough River. The study will include an assessment of potential developments and the transportation needs that will result from future development while taking in consideration approved zoning applications for both residential and commercial development, current development trend, full capacity of residence, commercial and business (industry). The study will also take into consideration the effect projected population growth within the COT, unincorporated Hillsborough County and surrounding counties that will commute to jobs and services within the downtown area; economic growth factors; existing and potential transit sources; existing and potential parking sources; special events held at the Ice Palace, Tampa Convention Center, Curtis Hixon Park, Port Authority, Downtown Riverwalk, Florida Aquarium and the impact of the Port Authority's Cruise terminals; and any other large scale traffic generators located adjacent to the study area that will impact the roadway network. The analysis will result in a list of improvements or development conditions that can be implemented in the study area and incorporated in the Comprehensive Plan. Total fees for the Study are anticipated to be approximately \$250,000.

A Pre-Submission Conference for this project will be conducted at 3:00PM Tuesday January 23rd, at 306 E. Jackson Street, Tampa, Florida, in the 4th Floor Conference Room. Attendance is not mandatory.
