PUBLIC ANNOUNCEMENT IN COMPLIANCE WITH REQUIREMENTS OF CHAPTER 287.055, LAWS OF FLORIDA, CONSULTANTS COMPETITIVE NEGOTIATION ACT, AS AMENDED AND THE CITY OF TAMPA'S WOMEN / MINORITY BUSINESS ENTERPRISE PROGRAM

RFQ- 7-D-45 - The City of Tampa desires to obtain Professional Engineering services as the City's **Resident Project Representative** during construction of certain **Utility Projects**.

Services may include acting as resident project representative, construction inspection, construction engineering, oversight of materials testing, coordination, review or other associated contract administration activities required during design, construction or commissioning of facilities.

While some elements of the work may require other resources of the selected firm, submittals shall identify and highlight the qualifications of the key individual who will serve as the project leader and be the primary day to day contact for project activities.

The value of the construction work to be administered under this contract is estimated to be from 100 to 200 million dollars over a few years.
