RFQ- 7-D-56 - The City of Tampa desires to obtain Professional Engineering and Architectural services associated with the design of the **Alline Avenue Stormwater Pumping Station**.

Services may include but not be limited to: Engineering, Architecture, Design, Permitting, services during construction, surveying; preparation of construction documents, coordination compliance with other governmental agencies; or any related activities.

The design project is estimated at \$400,000.

A Pre-Submission Conference for this project will be conducted at 3:00PM Tuesday May 1, 2007, at 306 E. Jackson Street, Tampa, Florida, in the 4th Floor Conference Room. Attendance is not mandatory.

Background: The project includes the pumping station, a force main across Bayshore Blvd to the Bay, a gravity pipe system delivering flows to the station, and improvements to the gravity stormwater system on MacDill Avenue.

Architectural concepts and preliminary pump and pipe sizing has been assembled by City Staff.
