A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE PROPOSAL OF VOLT INFORMATION SCIENCES, INC. PERTAINING TO CONTRACT NO. 6-C-3 FOR WATER SERVICE LINE REPLACEMENT IN THE COMPUTED TOTAL AMOUNT USED TO COMPARE PROPOSALS OF \$1,640,630.00; AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF THE CONTRACT BY THE MAYOR OF THE CITY OF TAMPA; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, on August 8, 2006, the Mayor received bids, a tabulation of which is attached hereto for informational purposes, for water service line replacement, Contract No. 6-C-3, and recommends to this Council that the Proposal of Volt Information Sciences, Inc. be accepted; and

WHEREAS, work at the unit prices bid shall be performed on a work order-by-work order basis, with each work order being approved and issued by the Director of the Water Department.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL
OF THE CITY OF TAMPA, FLORIDA:

Section 1. That the Proposal of Volt Information Sciences, Inc. (Contractor) in the computed total amount used to compare proposals of \$1,640,630.00 for water service line replacement, Contract No. 6-C-3 (Project), in accordance with specifications and other related contract documents prepared by the Water Department, is hereby approved and accepted; and the Contract is hereby awarded to said Contractor.

Section 2. That this Resolution, which is not part of the contract documents, authorizes the Mayor to execute and the City Clerk to attest and affix the official seal of the City of Tampa to the Contract for and on behalf of the City of Tampa.

Section 3. That the specifications and contract documents for said Project, which documents are now on file in the office of the Water Department, are hereby approved.

Section 4. That the Director of the Water Department is hereby authorized to issue, in written form only, work directive changes authorizing additions, deletions or revisions resulting from unforeseen conditions or emergencies; said directives to be incorporated in subsequently issued change orders approved by the City Council.

Section 5. That any and all technical errors, informalities and irregularities in the Proposal of the Contractor are hereby waived.

Section 6. That the bid security of the bidders shall be returned in accordance with the provisions of the contract documents for this Project.

Section 7. That the cost of the work orders issued under Contract No. 6-C-3 shall be obligated on a work order-by-work order basis and shall be paid from funds available in Accounts No. WT 04 43B AS-06300 and WT 04 43B AT-06300 of the Water Department.

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Section 8. That other proper officers of the City of Tampa are authorized to do all things necessary and proper in order to carry out and make effective the provisions of this Resolution, which shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
