4	Monitoring Phase	Potential Threat Sited	48-72 hours pre-landfall	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Advise Executive Policy Group of situation - Monitor progress - Conference calls - Assess vulnerability and decision times
3	Watch & Warning Phase	Take Action To Save Lives and Property	24-48 hours pre-landfall	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Resource pre-positioning - City EOC Activated - Regional evacuation decision - Pre-event public information
2	Initial Response Phase	Enhanced Readiness & Coordination	12-24 hours pre-landfall	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Initiate evacuation of affected areas - Recall emergency personnel - Monitor regional evacuation - Assess need to terminate
	Full Response Phase		Landfall	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - All hands on duty
1	Recovery Phase	Rapid Recovery & Restoration	Post-Storm (Time contingent upon damages)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Search and Rescue operations - Impact assessment - Debris clearance/Push Teams - Utility restoration initiated - Develop regional re-entry plan with counties - Post-event public information
