POLICE SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM-REQUIRED DOCUMENTS

Thank you for your interest in the Police Scholarship Program with the City of Tampa.

To be considered for the scholarship program you must submit a legible copy of each of the following documents with your application. Your application **will not be processed** until all required documents have been submitted to the Employment Services Office. Documents provided must be true, accurate, up-to-date, and without omission.

All scholarship applicants:

- Birth Certificate (U.S. passport may be submitted in lieu of a birth certificate)
- Proof of US Citizenship (U.S. naturalized citizens must furnish their naturalization number)
- High-School Diploma (or an equivalency certificate issued by a State Board of Education)
- Valid Florida Driver's License
- Associate's Degree or Two Years of College Credits (60-semester or 90-quarter hours)
(submit a transcript that verifies the number of earned college credits)

If applicable:

- Bachelor or Higher Level Diploma
- Department of Defense Form 214 (Military Discharge Long Form) stating "Character of Service"
- Letter indicating Veteran's Compensable Service-Connected Disability Rating
