

Riverwalk South Plaza

- The completion of this segment adds 1140 feet of Riverwalk, providing 0.8 miles of continuous Riverwalk from South Plaza to Brorein Street
 - 2.2 mile Riverwalk is now 41% complete
- Incorporates shade (mature trees and five shade structures)
- Includes a new art piece on the Riverwalk
 - *Riverwall* by Bruce Marsh is a 8' x 40' mural containing 550 photographs of the downtown waterfront and the Hillsborough River
- Significant connectivity
 - Channelside Bay Plaza, the Florida Aquarium, and the American Victory Ship
 - Gateway to Meridian Trail (located on the west side of Meridian Avenue)
 - Links to Harbour Island – completes a loop for walkers, runners, and bikers
 - Access to adjacent Streetcar stop just across Beneficial Drive
- Compliments the Tampa Bay History Center and Columbia Café, cenotaph and Heroes Plaza
- Plenty of parking available nearby (Port, Forum VIP lot and South Regional)
- Construction Funding - \$2.1 million
 - South Plaza to Tampa Bay History Center funded by a \$1.4 million State Economic Development Grant
 - Extended Cotanchobee Park and around the Tampa Bay History Center with Community Investment Tax funds of \$740,000
- Riverwalk marker on the southeast edge of the plaza provides a brief history of the Riverwalk
- New segment was built on city owned land as well as two parcels of donated land
 - Tampa Bay Lightning donated 1585 sq. ft. of land (under the mural)
 - Harbour Island Community Services Association donated approximately 600 sq. ft. under the west Harbour Island sign that was removed
