DESCRIPTION

All purchase contracts must be approved by the City's legal department and purchasing department and signed by the Mayor, regardless of the funding source.

For GIS software and licensing contracts, four software license contracts have been negotiated and are in place: one for all Autodesk products, including AutoCAD; one for all Bentley Systems products, including Microstation; one for all ESRI products, including ArcGIS; one for all Pitney Bowes products, including MapInfo; and one for all Oracle products, including Locator/Spatial. These contracts comply with the revised City of Tampa "Citywide IT Management Policy" concerning software purchases.

The T&I GIS Supervisor manages these contracts. All purchases of all Autodesk, Bentley, ESRI and Pitney Bowes products must be made using these contracts under the supervision of the Purchasing Department and with the coordination of the T&I GIS Section.
