Purpose of the EBOAC is to serve as a citizen advisory committee (i) to promote the participation and use of SLBE and, when authorized by law, WMBE businesses in City contracting and procurement and (ii) to relay concerns of minority contractors, women contractors, non-minority contractors and citizens at-large to the City about the operation of this program.

Membership:

- **The Equal Business Opportunity Advisory Council consists of 16 member.**

 - Initial appointments: Terms are to be staggered
 - All appointees shall be residents of the City of Tampa or Hillsborough County
