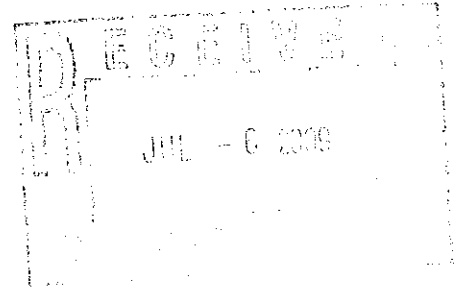

Dear Mr. Perry:

The Clean Water State Revolving Fund (CWSRF) program would like to thank you for the time and effort that was put forth in submitting your projects for the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (ARRA) funding. Since the documentation provided did not meet all requirements for the ARRA funds and was not completed according to the Rule 62-503.700, F.A.C. by the April 29, 2009 deadline, the Department determined that the wastewater treatment facility projects were not eligible to be listed for ARRA construction funding. These funds were allocated to projects that met all program and ARRA requirements based on the priority score until the available funds were exhausted. Sponsors that received funding were limited to a maximum of \$10 million dollars from the CWSRF program for that fiscal year.

Although all ARRA and traditional CWSRF funds have been allocated for the upcoming fiscal year, the CWSRF program will continue to conduct annual hearings to add projects. The next deadline for meeting all readiness to proceed requirements is June 1, 2010.
