A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE PROPOSAL OF TAMPA BAY CONSTRUCTION & ENGINEERING INC. PERTAINING TO CONTRACT 21-C-00028, YBOR 7TH AVE STREETSCAPE REHABILITATION - NUCCIO TO 26TH ST, IN THE AMOUNT OF \$897,765; AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF THE CONTRACT BY THE MAYOR OF THE CITY OF TAMPA; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, on July 12, 2022, the Mayor received bids, tabulation of such bids being hereto attached for informational purposes, for the construction of Ybor 7th Ave Streetscape Rehabilitation - Nuccio to 26th St, and recommends to this Council that the proposal of Tampa Bay Construction & Engineering Inc. be accepted, funds therefore being available in the appropriate account.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TAMPA, FLORIDA, THAT:

Section 1. The proposal of Tampa Bay Construction & Engineering Inc. in the total amount of \$897,765 for construction of the Ybor 7th Ave Streetscape Rehabilitation - Nuccio to 26th St, in accordance with plans, specifications and other related contract documents prepared by the Contract Administration Department, is hereby approved and accepted; and the Contract is hereby awarded to the said Contractor.

Section 2. This Resolution, which is not part of the contract documents, authorizes the Mayor to execute and the City Clerk to attest and affix the official seal of the City of Tampa to the Contract for and on behalf of the City of Tampa.

Section 3. Plans, specifications and contract documents for the construction of said Project, which documents are now on file in the office of the Contract Administration Department of the City of Tampa, are hereby approved in their entirety or in substantially similar form.

Section 4. The Director of the Contract Administration Department is hereby authorized to issue, in written form only, work directive changes authorizing additions, deletions or revisions resulting from unforeseen conditions or emergencies, said directives to be incorporated in subsequently issued change orders approved by the City Council.

Section 5. Any and all technical errors, informalities and irregularities in the proposal of the Contractor are hereby waived.

Section 6. The bid security of the bidders shall be returned in accordance with the provisions of the contract documents for this project.

Section 7. This resolution provides for construction services in the amount of \$897,765 for the East 7th Ave Archways & Streetscape Rehabilitation Project for the Ybor 1 and Ybor 2 Community Redevelopment Areas (CRAs) within the Ybor 1 and Ybor 2 CRA Funds.

Section 8. That the City Clerk shall file a fully executed copy of the Agreement in the official records of the City of Tampa as maintained by the Office of the City Clerk.

Section 9. Other proper officers of the City of Tampa are authorized to do all things necessary and proper in order to carry out and make effective the provisions of this Resolution, which shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.

The Equal Business Opportunity Office evaluated the Good Faith Effort Compliance Plan (GFCEP) submitted by Low Bidder Tampa Bay Construction & Engineering, Inc and determined they complied with the requirements of the Equal Business Opportunity Program (EBO) at time of bid by having performed meaningful action steps to (a) identify and (b) directly solicit Underutilized-WMBE and SLBE eligible companies to quote divisions of work commensurate with the participation goal. The project goal was narrowly tailored based on three (3) out of three (3) subcontract categories wherein the requisite, eligible U-WMBE and SLBE companies represented a minimum availability group of twenty (20+) firms, within an overall availability group of sixty (60+) available COT certified companies by subcontract tasks.

NOTE: The subcontract goal is narrowly tailored (per policy) to target underutilization of affected groups in specific trade/industry categories. Any WMBE/SLBE achievement that was not a variable in calculation of the narrowly tailored goal is considered ancillary. Ancillary participation cannot be credited toward meeting the narrowly tailored goal but may count toward the bidder's overall project participation when GFCEP criteria for the underutilized group are met.
