A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE PROPOSAL OF DAVID NELSON CONSTRUCTION CO. PERTAINING TO CONTRACT 19-C-00018; E COLUMBUS DRIVE FROM N NEBRASKA AVE (SR45) TO 14ST. BIKE LANE/SIDEWALK, IN THE AMOUNT OF \$4,152,367; AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF THE CONTRACT BY THE MAYOR OF THE CITY OF TAMPA; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, on August 4, 2020, the Mayor received bids, tabulation of such bids being hereto attached for informational purposes, for the construction of E Columbus Drive from N Nebraska Ave (SR45) to 14th St. Bike Lane/Sidewalk, and recommends to this Council that the proposal of David Nelson Construction Co. be accepted, funds therefore being available in the appropriate account;

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TAMPA, FLORIDA, THAT:

Section 1. The proposal of David Nelson Construction Co. in the total amount of \$4,152,367 for construction of the E Columbus Drive from N Nebraska Ave (SR45) to 14th St. Bike Lane/Sidewalk, in accordance with plans, specifications and other related contract documents prepared by the Contract Administration Department, is hereby approved and accepted; and the Contract is hereby awarded to the said Contractor.

Section 2. This Resolution, which is not part of the contract documents, authorizes the Mayor to execute and the City Clerk to attest and affix the official seal of the City of Tampa to the Contract for and on behalf of the City of Tampa.

Section 3. Plans, specifications and contract documents for the construction of said Project, which documents are now on file in the office of the Contract Administration Department of the City of Tampa, are hereby approved in their entirety or in substantially similar form.

Section 4. The Director of the Contract Administration Department is hereby authorized to issue, in written form only, work directive changes authorizing additions, deletions or revisions resulting from unforeseen conditions or emergencies, said directives to be incorporated in subsequently issued change orders approved by the City Council.


Section 5. Any and all technical errors, informalities and irregularities in the proposal of the Contractor are hereby waived.

Section 6. The bid security of the bidders shall be returned in accordance with the provisions of the contract documents for this project.


Section 7. This resolution provides \$4,152,367 for the East Columbus Drive From North Nebraska Avenue to 14th Street Project for use by the Mobility Department within the Transportation Grants Capital Projects Fund, the Local Option Gas Tax Capital Projects Fund, the FY16 Bank Note Fund, the Non Ad Valorem Bonds Series 2016 Capital Improvement Projects Fund, and the Community Redevelopment Agency (CRA) – East Tampa Fund.

Section 8. Other proper officers of the City of Tampa are authorized to do all things necessary and proper in order to carry out and make effective the provisions of this Resolution, which shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.

3. Contract Amount: \$4,152,367.00
4. Purpose: This agreement is for the construction contract services for the Columbus Dr. from N. Nebraska Ave. (SR 45) to 14th St. Complete Street Project. This is one of the recommended projects in the Metropolitan Planning Organization Tampa Walk-Bike Plan, Phase 1 Final Report. This Complete Street Project will include water, stormwater, and transportation improvements. The scope of services includes, but is not limited to, maintenance of traffic, roadway, signing, pavement markings, signalization, utilities adjustments/relocations, landscaping, and all associated work required for a complete project in accordance with the contract. This project provides for the reconfiguration of the existing 2-lane, undivided street to provide bicycle accommodation and on-street parking aisles on both sides of the street. 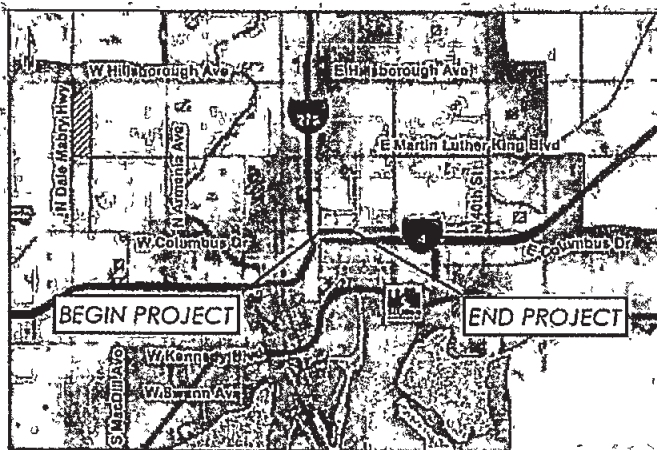

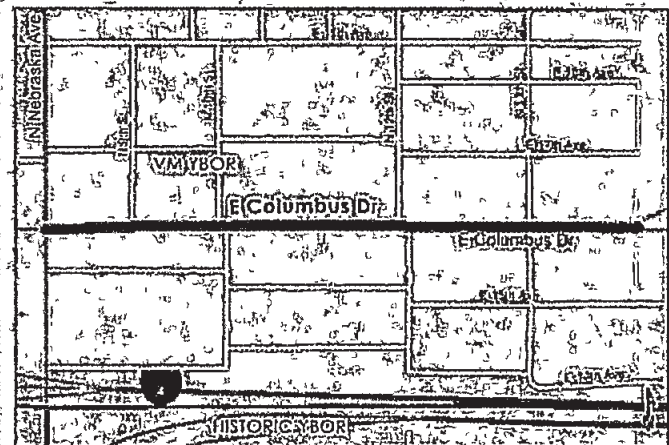


City Council Districts

Overview Map



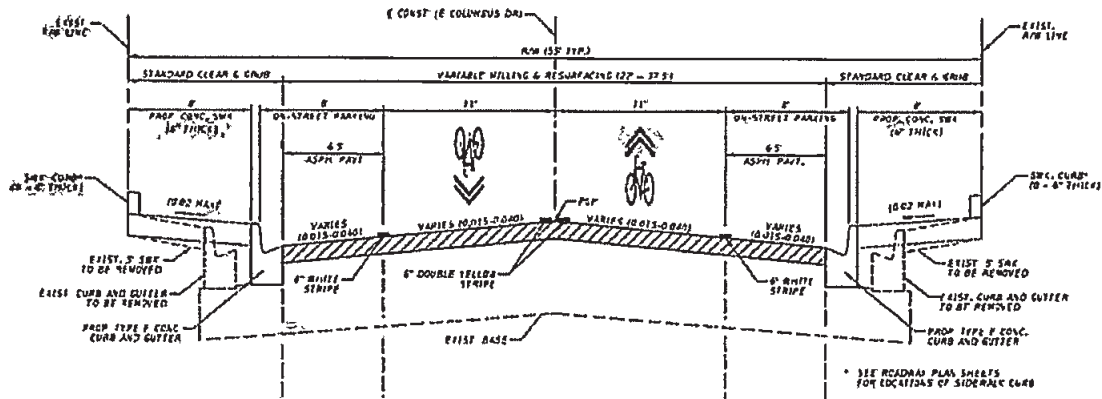

Project Description

The E. Columbus Drive Complete Streets and Safety Improvements project provides for the reconfiguration of the existing 2-lane, undivided street to provide two 11-ft travel lanes with shared lane bicycle pavement markings, 8-ft wide sidewalks with ADA upgrades, and 8-ft wide inset parking on both sides of the roadway. The project will include intersection and mid-block curb extensions with decorative crosswalks and pedestrian actuated rectangular rapid flashing beacons (RRFB), and reconstruction of the relocated curbs and gutters. The project also includes green infrastructure including landscaping and tree wells to provide sustainable stormwater drainage.

This 0.4-mile 2-lane segment of E. Columbus Drive is an arterial roadway with an average daily traffic volume of 10,210 vehicles and posted speed of 30 miles per hour. The Hillsborough County Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO)/City of Tampa Walk-Bike Plan Phase I- Final Report identified the E. Columbus Drive project as the fourth highest priority walk-bike project for the City. The City's InVision Center City Plan also identified this segment of E. Columbus Drive as a key corridor to provide safe, walkable, and bikeable neighborhood connectivity.

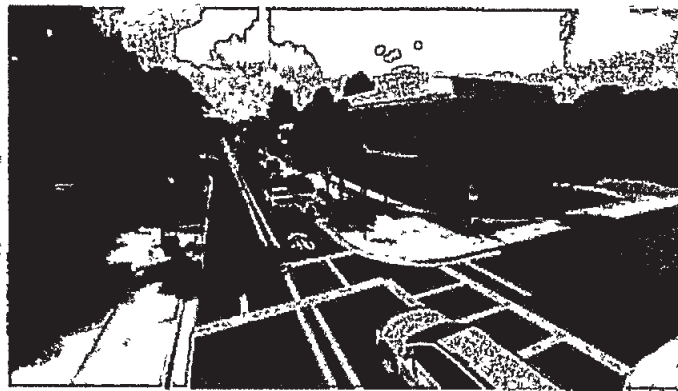
