A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE PROPOSAL OF GOSALIA CONCRETE CONTRACTORS, INC. PERTAINING TO CONTRACT 19-C-00046; 46TH STREET FROM SR 580 (BUSCH BLVD) TO SR 582 (FOWLER AVE) BIKE LANE/SIDEWALK, IN THE AMOUNT OF \$3,062,445.99; AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF THE CONTRACT BY THE MAYOR OF THE CITY OF TAMPA; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, on July 28, /2020, the Mayor received bids, tabulation of such bids being hereto attached for informational purposes, for the construction of 46th Street from SR 580 (Busch Blvd) to SR 582 (Fowler Ave) Bike Lane/Sidewalk, and recommends to this Council that the proposal of Gosalia Concrete Contractors, Inc. be accepted, funds therefore being available in the appropriate account;

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TAMPA, FLORIDA, THAT:

Section 1. The proposal of Gosalia Concrete Contractors, Inc. in the total amount of \$3,062,445.99 for construction of the 46th Street from SR 580 (Busch Blvd) to SR 582 (Fowler Ave) Bike Lane/Sidewalk, in accordance with plans, specifications and other related contract documents prepared by the Contract Administration Department, is hereby approved and accepted; and the Contract is hereby awarded to the said Contractor.

Section 2. This Resolution, which is not part of the contract documents, authorizes the Mayor to execute and the City Clerk to attest and affix the official seal of the City of Tampa to the Contract for and on behalf of the City of Tampa.

Section 3. Plans, specifications and contract documents for the construction of said Project, which documents are now on file in the office of the Contract Administration Department of the City of Tampa, are hereby approved in their entirety or in substantially similar form.

Section 4. The Director of the Contract Administration Department is hereby authorized to issue, in written form only, work directive changes authorizing additions, deletions or revisions resulting from unforeseen conditions or emergencies, said directives to be incorporated in subsequently issued change orders approved by the City Council.


Section 5. Any and all technical errors, informalities and irregularities in the proposal of the Contractor are hereby waived.

Section 6. The bid security of the bidders shall be returned in accordance with the provisions of the contract documents for this project.



This resolution provides \$3,062,445.99 for the 46th Street From Busch Boulevard to Fowler Avenue Project for use by the Mobility Department within the Transportation Grants Capital Projects Fund, the North Central District Transportation Impact Fee Fund, the University North District Transportation Impact Fee Fund, the Local Option Gas Tax Capital Projects Fund, the Multi Modal CIP Central East Fund, the Multi Modal CIP North Central Fund, and the Multi Modal CIP University North Fund.

Section 8. Other proper officers of the City of Tampa are authorized to do all things necessary and proper in order to carry out and make effective the provisions of this Resolution, which shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.

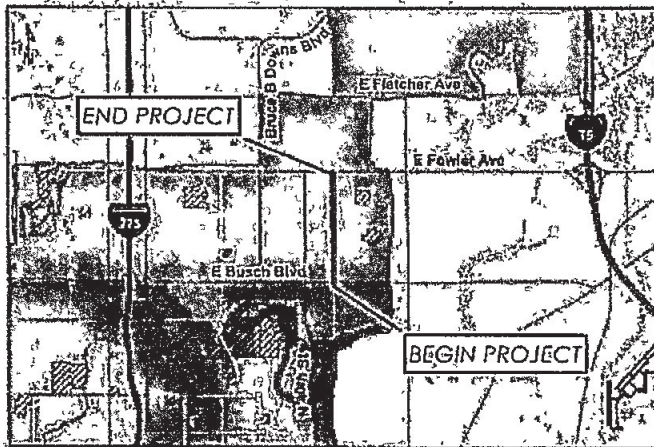

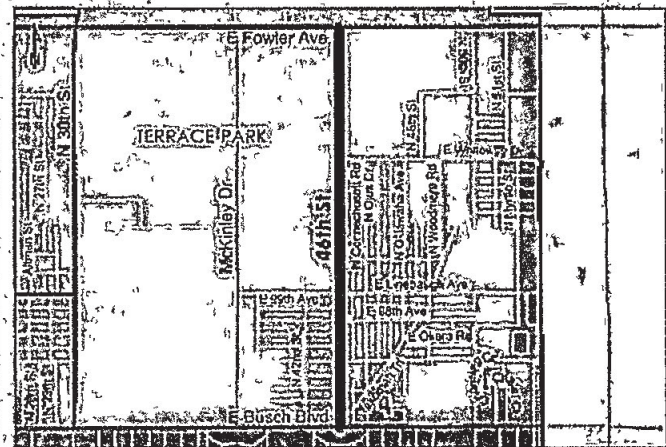

Project Description

This project provides for complete street roadway improvements to enhance safety and multimodal connectivity, including a roundabout, sidewalks, bicycle facilities, enhanced crosswalks and other safety measures. The 1.5 mile segment of 46th Street from Busch Boulevard to Fowler Avenue is a 2-lane (one travel lane in each direction) Collector roadway with a posted speed of 35 mph and has an average daily traffic volume of 3,880 vehicles per day. The proposed improvements are summarized as follows:

- Install shared lane markings from Busch Boulevard to Bougainvillea Avenue;
- Widen the sidewalk to construct a shared use path from Bougainvillea Avenue to Fowler Avenue;
- Roundabout at Linebaugh Avenue;
- Signalization improvements at Bougainvillea Avenue;
- Enhanced pedestrian crosswalk with Rectangular Rapid Flashing Beacon (RRFB) at Whiteway Drive;
- Mid-block pedestrian crosswalk with RRFB 1,000 ft south of Fowler Avenue;
- Reducing posted speed limit from 35-mph to 30-mph.

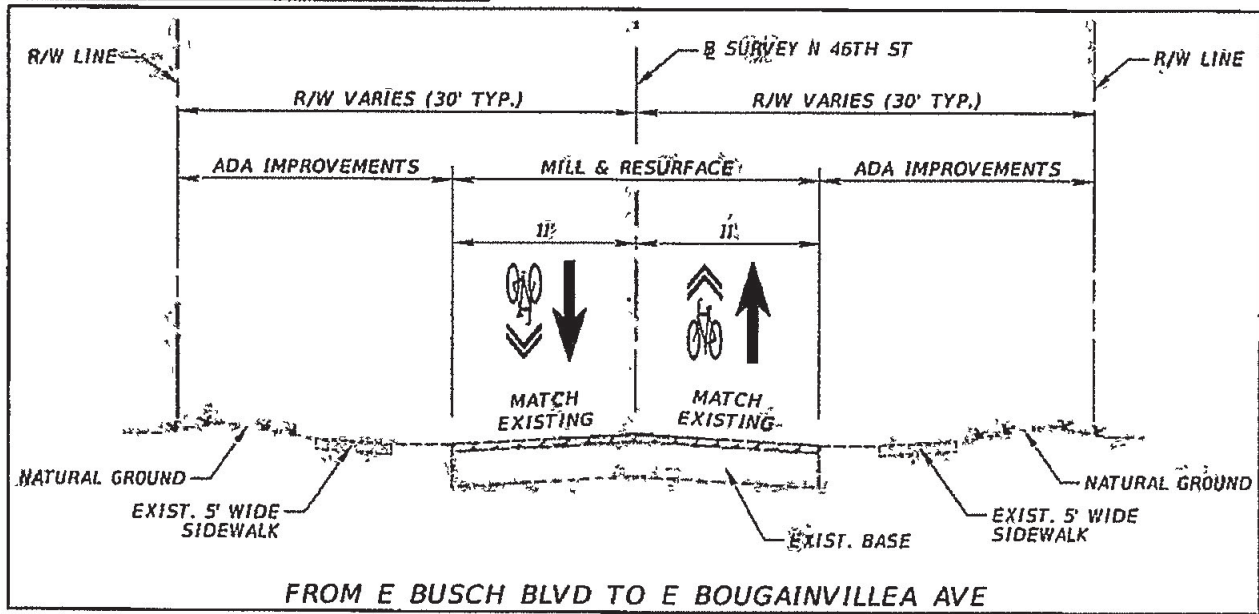


Figure 1- Proposed Typical Cross Section

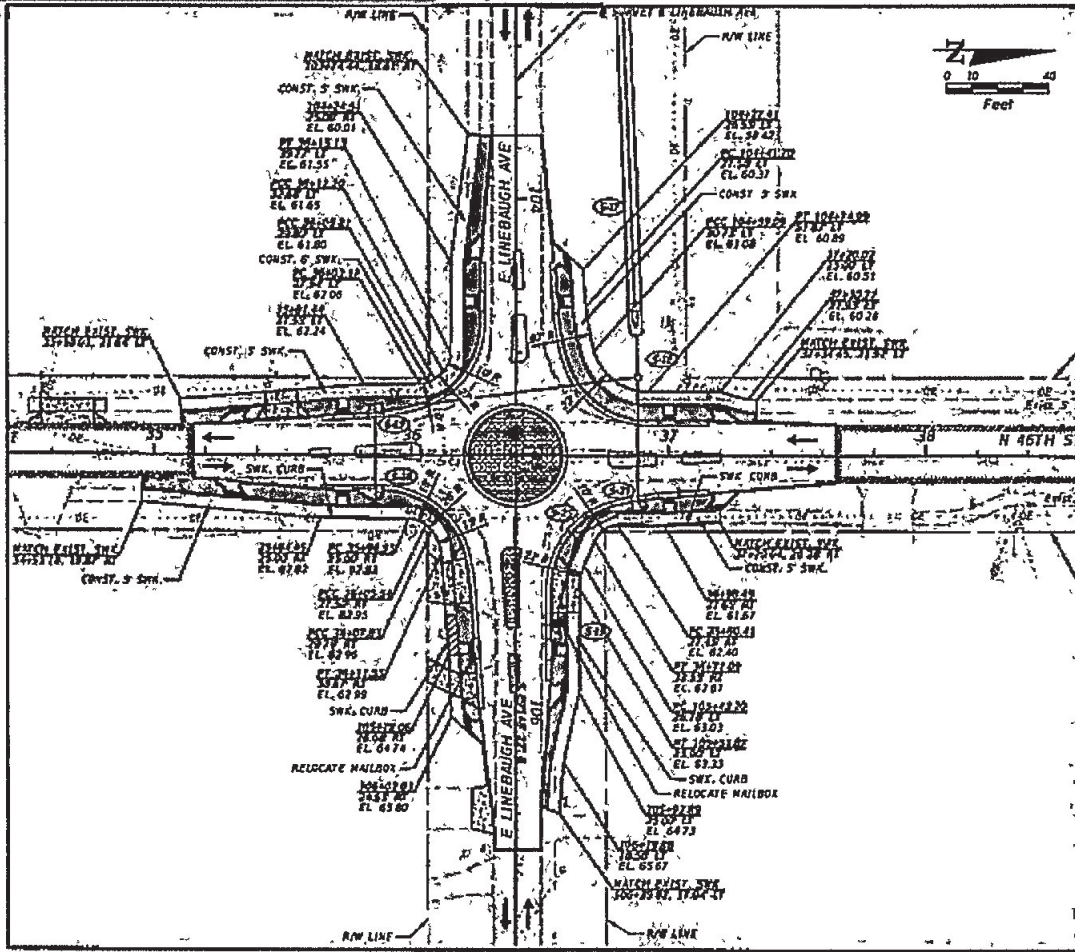


Figure 2- Graphic of proposed mini-roundabout at 46th Street and Linebaugh Avenue.
