**A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE PROPOSAL OF VOGEL BROS. BUILDING CO. PERTAINING TO CONTRACT 14-C-00009; KRAUSE PUMP STATION REHABILITATION, IN THE AMOUNT OF \$6,820,000; AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF THE CONTRACT BY THE MAYOR OF THE CITY OF TAMPA; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

WHEREAS, on August 5, 2014, the Mayor received bids, tabulation of such bids being hereto attached for informational purposes, for the construction of Krause Pump Station Rehabilitation, and recommends to this Council that the proposal of Vogel Bros. Building Co. be accepted, funds therefore being available in the appropriate account;

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL  
OF THE CITY OF TAMPA, FLORIDA, THAT:

Section 1. The proposal of Vogel Bros. Building Co. in the total amount of \$6,820,000 for construction of the Krause Pump Station Rehabilitation, in accordance with plans, specifications and other related contract documents prepared by the Contract Administration Department, is hereby approved and accepted; and the Contract is hereby awarded to the said Contractor.

Section 2. This Resolution, which is not part of the contract documents, authorizes the Mayor to execute and the City Clerk to attest and affix the official seal of the City of Tampa to the Contract for and on behalf of the City of Tampa.

Section 3. Plans, specifications and contract documents for the construction of said Project, which documents are now on file in the office of the Contract Administration Department of the City of Tampa, are hereby approved in their entirety or in substantially similar form.

Section 4. The Director of the Contract Administration Department is hereby authorized to issue, in written form only, work directive changes authorizing additions, deletions or revisions resulting from unforeseen conditions or emergencies, said directives to be incorporated in subsequently issued change orders approved by the City Council.

Section 5. Any and all technical errors, informalities and irregularities in the proposal of the Contractor are hereby waived.

Section 6. The bid security of the bidders shall be returned in accordance with the provisions of the contract documents for this project.

Section 7. This Resolution provides for award of a contract for construction services in the amount of \$6,820,000 for the Krause Pump Station Rehabilitation project within the Wastewater Capital Construction Fund.

Section 8. Other proper officers of the City of Tampa are authorized to do all things necessary and proper in order to carry out and make effective the provisions of this Resolution, which shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.





The Minority and Small Business Development Office evaluated the Good Faith Effort Compliance Plan (GFECPP) submitted by Vogel Brothers Building Company and determined they complied with the requirements of the Equal Business Opportunity Ordinance by having performed meaningful action steps to solicit SLBE/U-WMBE participation commensurate with the goal.


Subsequent to MBD completing the GFECPP Compliance Review of the bidder's subcontract solicitation/utilization forms (MBD 10-20), Vogel Brothers Building Company provided an executed Letter of Intent (LOI) from Terrell Industries (SLBE/BBE for \$946,410.51 (or 13.9%). Terrell Industries was one of the SLBE/U-WMBE subcontractors included in initial subcontractor outreach. The additional subcontract information was not confirmed in the initial compliance evaluation at bid opening (i.e., Met Compliant Approval). The detailed Compliance Report is attached and should be made a part of the project file.

*Note: The subcontract goal is narrowly-tailored (per policy) to target underutilization of affected groups in specific trade/industry categories. Any WMBE/SLBE achievement that was not a variable in calculation of the project-specific goal is considered ancillary. Ancillary participation is counted in the overall participation and may be credited toward meeting the narrowly-tailored goal when underutilization criteria are met.*

**Compliance Statement:** Overall SLBE/U-WMBE participation is 13.9%, of which 13.9% represents BBE.
