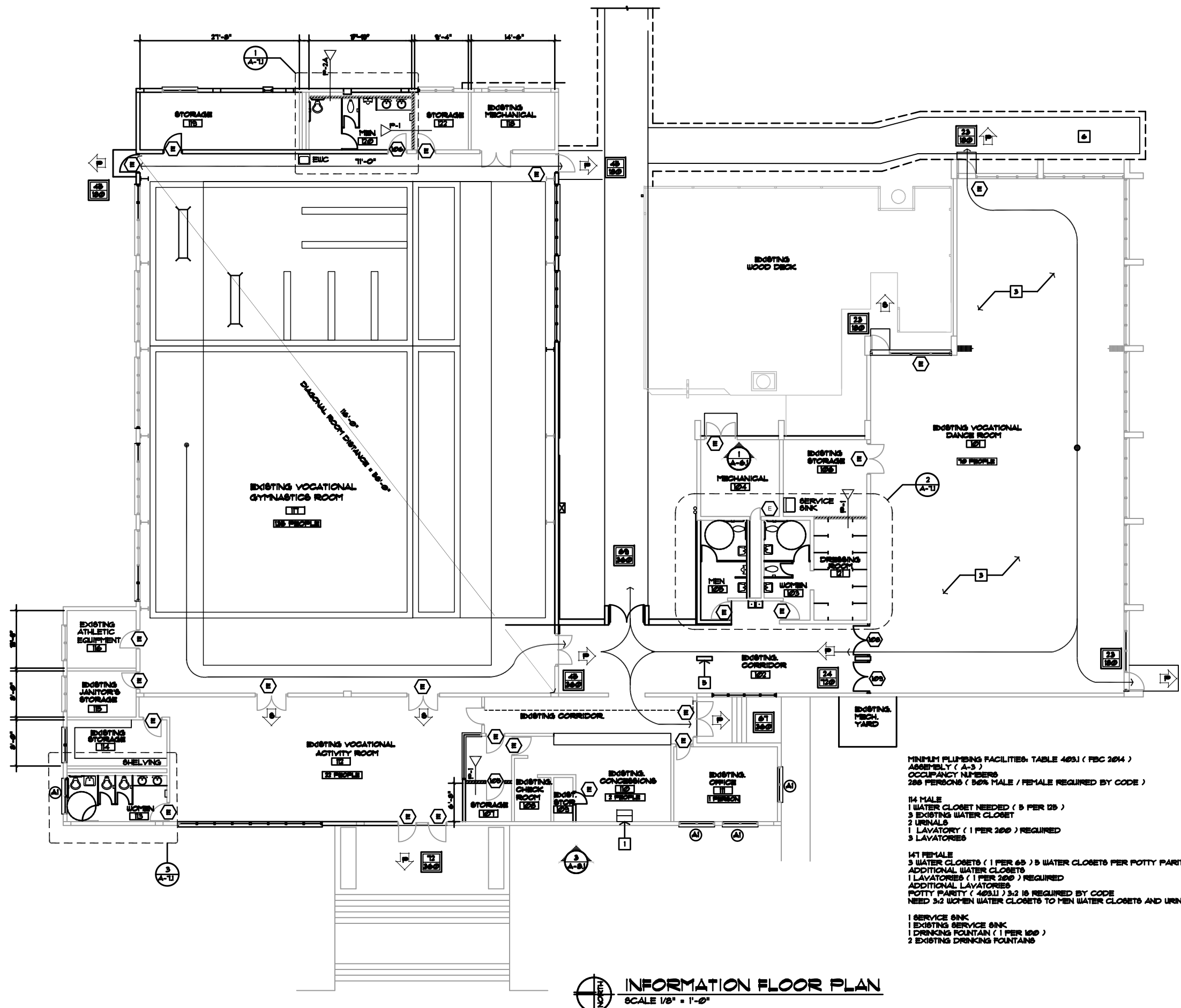

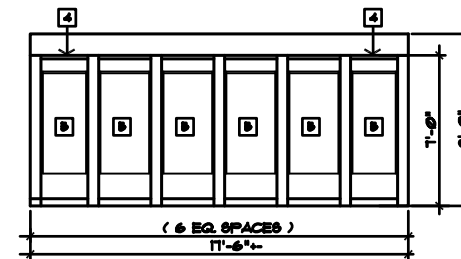
**ELEVATION 4**

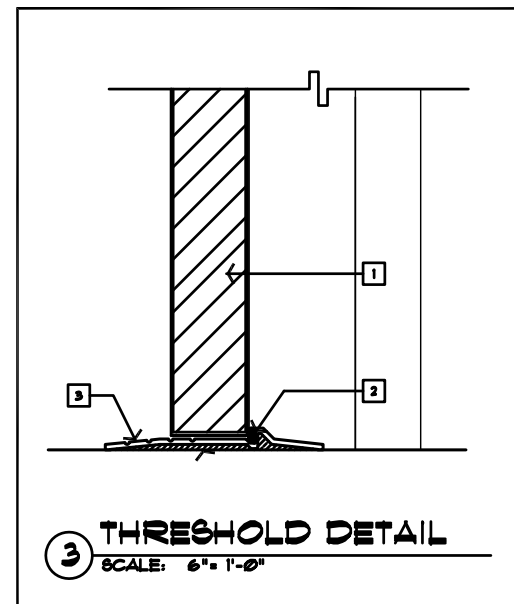
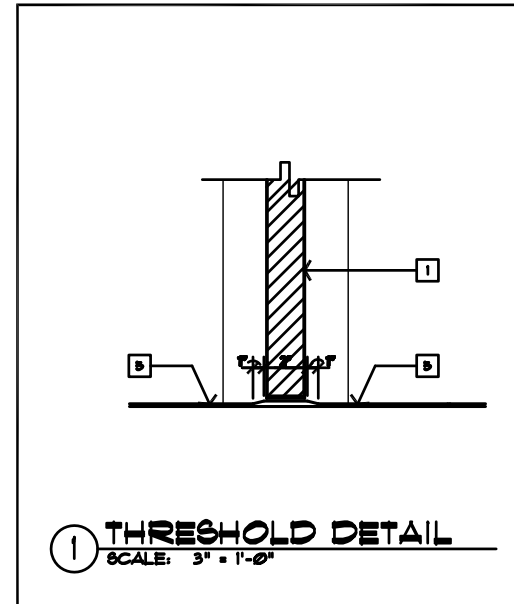
