**Whereas**, the Sister City Program, administered by Sister Cities International® was initiated by the President of the United States of America in 1956 to encourage greater friendship and understanding between the United States and other nations through direct personal contact; and

**Whereas**, in order to foster those goals, the people of the City of Tampa, Florida, United States of America, and South Dublin County, Ireland, in a gesture of friendship and goodwill, agree to collaborate for the mutual benefit of their communities by exploring educational, economic and cultural opportunities.

**Whereas**, we agree to support and encourage opportunities for mutually beneficial practical exchanges in the fields of Arts, Culture, Health, Science, Education, Tourism and Business.

**Now Therefore**, the City of Tampa and South Dublin County do hereby proclaim themselves Sister Cities, and declare their intent to abide by these guidelines indefinitely according to the Sister Cities International® policies.
