

ORDINANCE NO. 2008- 202

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF TAMPA, FLORIDA,  
AMENDING THE CITY OF TAMPA CODE, CHAPTER 15,  
SECTION 15-104, RESIDENTIAL PARKING PERMIT ONLY  
AREA TO PROVIDE FOR A RESIDENTIAL PARKING PERMIT  
ONLY AREA LOCATED IN THE COURIER CITY AND  
OSCAWANA NEIGHBORHOODS; PROVIDING FOR REPEAL  
OF ALL ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT; PROVIDING FOR  
SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, within the Courier City and Oscawana neighborhoods, there is a heavy concentration of vehicles during certain times of the day which prevents residents within those areas from having reasonable access to their homes; and

WHEREAS, the presence of these vehicles causes vehicular congestion on residential streets, impedes the movement of traffic and unduly restricts travel of residents within the area; and

WHEREAS, to help alleviate these conditions the City of Tampa desires to establish a "Residential Parking Permit Only Area", within Courier City and Oscawana neighborhoods; and

WHEREAS, the establishment of this residential parking permit only area will help alleviate the hardship for those residents of the Courier City and Oscawana neighborhoods who own vehicles and do not have the ability to secure off street parking, will aid in the preservation of the character of these areas as residential neighborhoods and the preservation of property values; and

WHEREAS, the creation of this residential parking permit only area serves a public purpose and is necessary to promote the health, safety and welfare of the inhabitants of the City; and

WHEREAS, the City of Tampa Department of Public Works recommends that the parameters defining the residential guest-parking permit area as described in Section 15-104, City of Tampa Code of Ordinances be amended to include certain streets located within the Courier City and Oscawana neighborhoods; and

WHEREAS, duly noticed public hearings as required by law were held by the City Council of the City of Tampa, Florida; and


WHEREAS, all parties in interest and citizens were afforded notice and an opportunity to be heard at said hearings; and


