There are lots of things to see here. It might be bright or hurt my eyes in places where I see this. I can wear sunglasses or cover my eyes.




There are lots of things to touch here. There might be things that I feel uncomfortable touching when I see this. I do not have to touch anything that I do not want to.

Rules

There will be rules that I have to follow when I am at the Park. There will be signs that remind me of what the rules are.



Trash

I will make sure I throw my trash into trash cans when I am finished with it. If I have a service animal with me I will make sure I clean up after him or her.



Water & Rest

If I get tired there will be places in the park where I can sit and rest or get a drink of water. There are water fountains for my service animals too if I have one.



The Playground

There will be a playground where I can play. I will take turns on the equipment if there are other kids there. I will stay on the playground where the adult that is with me can see me.



Things to do

While at the playground, there will be lots of things that we can look at or play with, like the swings and slides. I will ask the adult that is with me if I can touch and play with the sand before I touch it.



Time to cool off



While we are there, we can play in the water fountain. We have to ask the adult with us before we play in the water. Remember, there is no running in the water.



Noise

There might also be a lot of noise in the park. I can cover my ears or put on headphones if it get too load.
