Freedom Playground is Tampa's first boundless playground where children of all abilities can play side by side. The playground features easy-to-navigate surfaces and wide ramps as well as inclusive swings, seesaws, slides and sensory stimulation areas

The park has outdoor ADA restroom facilities as well as ADA restrooms, which is located inside the community center located on the property.

Notes

The park will be very busy on Saturdays during Little League Baseball/Softball Season. The seasons usually run September to December and February to June.

There are large shelters located near the playground, which can be reserved in advance through our online shelter reservation process.

The Community Center is open:
Monday and Thursday 8 am -7 pm
Tuesday and Wednesday 8 am - 5 pm
Friday 8 am - 4 pm

There are lots of things to see here. It might be bright or hurt my eyes in places where I see this. I can wear sunglasses or cover my eyes.




There are lots of things to touch here. There might be things that I feel uncomfortable touching when I see this. I do not have to touch anything that I do not want to.



There might be a strong smell in places where I see this. I can hold my nose or cover my nose with something that smells good.




When I see this there will be things I can taste here. I do not have to put anything in my mouth if I do not want to.

Rules

There will be rules that I have to follow when I am at the Park. There will be signs to remind me of what the rules.



Trash

I will make sure I throw my trash into trash cans. If I have a service animal with me, I will make sure I clean up after him or her.



Water & Rest

If I get tired, there will be places in the park where I can sit and rest or get a drink of water.



Restrooms

While we are in the park, we might need to use the restroom. We ask the adult we are with before we go to the restroom.



Freedom Playground

There will be a playground where I can play. I will take turns with other kids on the equipment. I will stay on the playground where the adult that is with me can see me.



Things to do

While at the playground, there will be lots of things that we can look at or play with, like this sand. I will ask the adult that is with me if I can touch and play with the sand before I touch it.



Noise

There might also be a lot of noise in the park. I can cover my ears or put on headphones if it gets too loud.
