RESOLUTION NO. 2018- 248

A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING A SCHEDULE OF FEES FOR THE PROCESSING OF APPLICATIONS FOR BATH TECHNICIAN AND BATHHOUSE BUSINESS PERMITS, FILED WITH THE CITY OF TAMPA'S PLANNING AND DEVELOPMENT DEPARTMENT, FOR REGULATION OF ACTIVITIES PURSUANT TO CHAPTER 6 OF THE CITY OF TAMPA CODE; RESCINDING ALL RESOLUTIONS IN CONFLICT; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Chapter 166, the "Municipal Home Rule Powers Act", secures for municipalities the broad exercise of home rule powers granted by the Florida Constitution; and

WHEREAS, sub-section 166.021(1), Florida Statutes, states that municipalities shall have the governmental, corporate, and proprietary powers to enable them to conduct municipal government, perform municipal functions, and render municipal services, and may exercise any power for municipal purposes; and

WHEREAS, City Council passed Ordinance 2018-1 concerning the regulation and permitting of bathhouses and bathhouse technicians on January 11, 2018, which was approved by the Mayor on January 17, 2018; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance 2018-1 requires an application and permitting process to be administered by the Planning and Development Department in coordination with the Tampa Police Department, which is responsible for background checks and inspections; and

WHEREAS, the City Administration has presented evidence to the City Council regarding the cost of processing applications and issuing permits under Ordinance 2018-1 filed with the Planning and Development Department and the cost of conducting background checks and inspections by the Tampa Police Department, under Ordinance 2018-1, enacting 6-156 through 6-167, City of Tampa Code (the "Code"); and

WHEREAS, after review, City Council has determined that the fees presented by the Administration represent the City's costs in processing the aforementioned applications and issuing the permits; and

WHEREAS, the fees being charged pursuant to this resolution are consistent with the City's cost in processing these applications and issuing these permits; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with section 166.041, Florida Statutes, a resolution is appropriate when concerning matters of administration.

NOW, THEREFORE,

**BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL
OF THE CITY OF TAMPA, FLORIDA:**

Section 1. That pursuant to the authority of Chapter 6, City of Tampa Code, the following shall be the fee schedule for fees relating to Planning and Development Department ("PDD") and the Tampa Police Department ("TPD") activities as provided under Ordinance 2018-1, Code sections 6-156 through 6-167:

Application Filing-Review Fee

Bath Technician:	\$ 88.00 (PDD)
Bathhouse:	\$ 176.00 (PDD)

Permit Cards/Placards (per card/placard issued)

Bath Technician:	\$ 3.00 (PDD)
Bathhouse:	\$ 5.00 (PDD)

Background Check (per person)

Bath Technician:	\$ 54.00 (TPD)
Bathhouse:	\$ 54.00 (TPD)

Inspections (total for annual permit period)

Bathhouse:	\$ 648.00 (TPD)

Section 2. That the proper officers of the City of Tampa be and they are hereby authorized and directed to do all things necessary and proper in order to carry out and make effective the provisions of this Resolution.

Section 3. That the fees set by this resolution shall increase every two (2) years from the date of adoption, at a rate consistent with the Cost of Living Index used by the City for annual salary adjustments, to reflect the increased costs incurred by the City to process the aforementioned Applications.

Section 4. That any other line item of a resolution that established a fee schedule for the same activities described in Section 1 hereof, is hereby repealed.

Section 5. That this Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
