

URBAN FOREST MANAGEMENT
NATURAL RESOURCES ADVISORY COMMITTEE
PURPOSE

- **Purpose:** Address issues to promote government efficiency by annually reviewing the Urban Forest Management Plan audit and making recommendations on the alternatives for action to be addressed to the Planning Department.

- **Resolution 2013-921**, paragraphs 5, 6, and 7 state: *“Whereas, to insure continued progress and implementation of the Urban Forest Management Plan, the Plan calls for the ongoing continuation of the Internal Technical Advisory Committee and the creation of an Advisory Committee on Natural Resources, which will be comprised of members from a variety of government, business, and neighborhood interests; and Whereas, on a semi-annual basis, the internal technical advisory committee will be responsible for reviewing the implementation of each 5-year list of preferred alternatives for action derived from the Plan, and reporting those findings to the Advisory Committee on Natural Resources; and Whereas, on an annual basis, both committees will hold a joint session to discuss accomplishments and recommended strategies for accomplishing the scheduled objectives from the Plan, and publish a report of those findings for distribution to the City Council, Administration, and the general public.”*

- **Executive Order 2014-1**, paragraph 3, states in part: *“Whereas, to insure balance, consistency, and efficiency in interdepartmental coordination and public engagement, the plan calls for the formation of an Internal Technical Working Group comprised of department directors and their appointed designees, and the creation of an Advisory Committee on Natural Resources, which will be comprised of members from a variety of government, business, and neighborhood interests.”*
