

# Proclamation

**WHEREAS**, the Fraternal Order of Sant' Yago, the famous order to which the Brotherhood of the "Caballeros" of the Royal Order of St. James is dedicated, played a powerful role in the history of Spain; and

**WHEREAS**, just as this order in Spain contributed to the growth and prosperity of that country, the Krewe of the Knights of Sant' Yago in Tampa, Florida has dedicated itself to the perpetuation and enhancement of their proud Latin heritage and to the continued improvement of life and cultural progress in our city; and

**WHEREAS**, originally discussed in 1970, the Krewe was formally organized in 1972 with a charter membership of 75, with the first Coronation in January of 1973; and

**WHEREAS**, today, the **Krewe of the Knights of Sant' Yago** boasts a full membership of 250 and is represented each year by an El Rey (King) and his La Reina (Queen) and her Royal Court of Ladies in Waiting, Courtesans, Pages, Attendants and a Royal Sword Bearer, and Las Damas, the Ladies Auxiliary; and

**WHEREAS**, in an effort to share their heritage and history, the organization annually sponsors the **Sant' Yago Illuminated Knight Parade** in Historic Ybor City as part of our city's Gasparilla festivities and participates in other cultural affairs throughout the year; and

**WHEREAS**, supporting the Tampa Bay area since 1994, the **Education Foundation of the Knights of Sant' Yago** is known for its community based philanthropic history, contributing in excess of one million dollars through scholarships, endowments and matching funds, and its goal is to improve Tampa Bay professionally and economically through higher education, and annually the organization hosts its **Sant' Yago Education Foundation Proclamation Dinner**, this year held on Thursday, January 31, 2019 at The Italian Club in historic Ybor City; and

**WHEREAS**, as did the original order in Spain several hundred years ago, the members of the Krewe of the Knights of Sant' Yago in Tampa have built closeness and fellowship, and have enhanced our entire community with its spirit and dedication to preserving our city's rich history, heritage and culture.

**NOW, THEREFORE**, I, Bob Buckhorn, by virtue of the authority vested in me as Mayor of the city of Tampa, Florida, do hereby proclaim the week of February 2-9, 2019 as
