**SUBJECT: 30th Street Complete Streets Sidewalk & Safety Improvement Project; CIP#1001530**

Due to executive orders declaring a state of emergency related to the coronavirus disease (COVID-19), the City of Tampa Mobility Department will hold an interactive live event online instead of holding an in-person public meeting for this project. This virtual meeting will be of no charge. Details for this virtual meeting are below:

The **30th Street Complete Streets Sidewalk & Safety Improvement Project** online Public Meeting will include a narrated presentation. City staff will be available to respond to project-related questions and concerns following the presentation. All meeting materials will be available on the project website, <https://www.tampagov.net/tss-transportation/info/projects/30thStCompleteSts>, beginning August 13, 2020. The website also provides the email link for submitting your feedback to the City.

Currently, 30th Street is a four-lane divided minor arterial with a center two-way left-turn lane, railroad track crossing, and a posted speed of 45 MPH from Busch Boulevard to Fowler Avenue. South of Busch Boulevard, 30th Street is a two-lane collector road with a posted speed of 30 MPH and a school crossing. Several transit

shelters/stops are located along 30th Street. The City is looking for public input to improve the corridor to make it safer for all users in accordance with the City's Vision Zero initiative.


Currently, the City is considering the development of possible improvements within the project limits (the 1.8 mile stretch of 30<sup>th</sup> Street from Yukon Street to Fowler Avenue), including roundabouts at the intersections of Yukon Street and Bougainvillea Avenue, enhanced pedestrian crosswalks near pedestrian attractors, intermittent landscaped medians, bike lanes, additional or widened sidewalks and trails, landscaping, and resilient drainage infrastructure.

In accordance with the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) and Section 286.26, Florida Statutes, persons with disabilities needing reasonable accommodation to participate in this public meeting should contact the City of Tampa's ADA Coordinator at least 48 hours prior to the proceedings. For such a purpose, they may need to hire a court reporter to ensure that a verbatim record of the proceedings is made, which includes the testimony and evidence upon which the appeal is to be based.
