



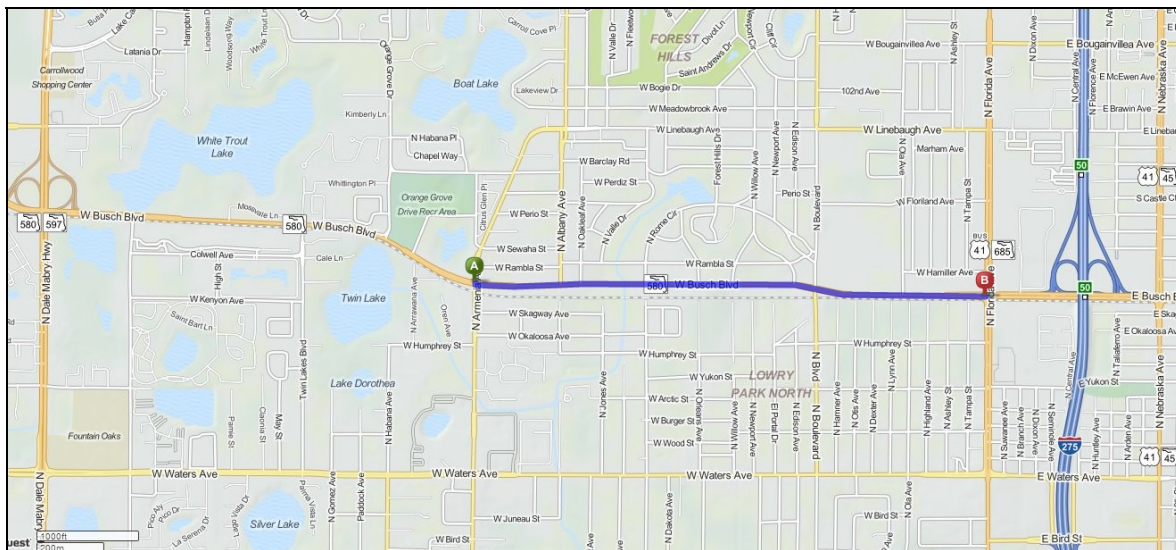
Busch Blvd Pedestrian Safety Improvements

Project Description:

W. Busch Blvd (SR 580) from N. Armenia Ave to N. Florida Ave is a four-lane, State Principal Arterial that is undivided on the western mile, and divided on the eastern half-mile. The project will include improvements to pedestrian safety and accessibility within existing right-of-way and will continue the previously completed improvements to the adjacent segment from Florida Ave to 56th St. The proposed safety enhancements include ADA ramp repairs and installations, countdown pedestrian signalization and crosswalk upgrades, including special emphasis striping. Sidewalk repairs and gaps on the north side will be addressed, as well as new segments of sidewalk on the south side of the roadway, to the west of North Boulevard where existing right-of-way will accommodate. The N. Boulevard intersection will be upgraded with pole and mast arm signalization, pedestrian countdown signalization and special emphasis crosswalks. Two traffic cameras will be added to improve congestion management, - one at Armenia Ave and one at North Boulevard. No acquisition of right-of-way is proposed.
