

## Water Distribution System Valve Assessment, Repair & Replacement Project

### PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The Water Distribution System Valve Assessment, Repair & Replacement Project will entail a comprehensive assessment of the water valves located in the areas surrounding Raymond James Stadium. Any valves identified as inoperable or at the end of their life expectancy will be repaired or replaced as needed. Several new fire hydrants may also be installed for increased fire protection.

These improvements will allow work crews to more easily isolate and control the flow of water to specific sections of the water distribution system if there's a water main break or other significant leak. As a result, these upgrades should minimize the number of customers affected by water service interruptions and allow for faster repairs.



### PROJECT SCOPE

The Water Department anticipates that this project will involve assessing the condition of several hundred valves, making repairs and replacements as necessary.

### POTENTIAL IMPACT ON AREA RESIDENTS & BUSINESSES

We may need to temporarily reroute traffic for short periods of time to effect certain repairs. Some homes and businesses may also occasionally experience fluctuations in water pressure.

### PROJECT LOCATION

This project will impact several areas near to the stadium including sections of Drew Park, MacFarlane Park, and Plaza Terrace.

### PROJECT DURATION

This project is slated to begin early July 2020 and end by mid-December 2020.
